FRIDAY.**

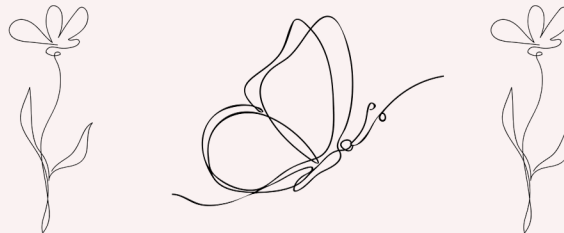
Please don't bring or wear perfumes/impulse to camp as we have a number of ladies with severe allergies to many fragrances/chemicals. This includes natural oils.

Power board & extension cord with your name on it, if you are using a machine.

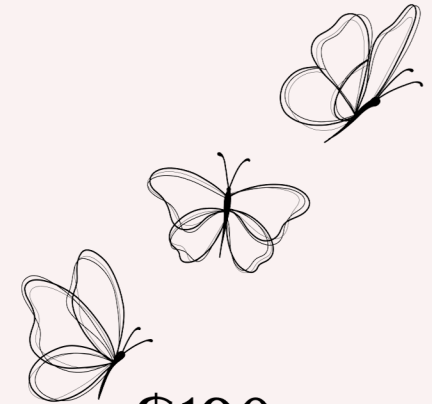
You are welcome to sell your own homemade crafts from your tables over the weekend.

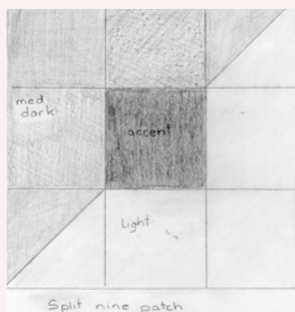

WORKSHOP 4 **Foundation Paper Piecing with Clare Montgomery**



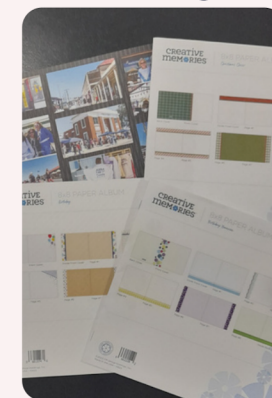
Celebration Wreath block size 34x34".
